Edited by an international board of leading scholars from various disciplines specializing in some aspect of Islamic studies, Middle Eastern studies or human right, MWJHR promises to serve as a forum in which barriers are bridged (or at least, addressed), and human rights are finally discussed with an eye on the Muslim world, in an open and creative manner.

The Muslim World Journal of Human Rights welcomes research from a spectrum of disciplines including (but not limited to) political science, sociology, anthropology, religious studies and philosophy. The research can cover either theoretical or practical aspects of human rights issues in the Muslim World. It should be noted that the journal provides a forum for the analysis of human rights issues related not only to Islam and Islamic law, but equally those human rights issues found in Muslim societies that stem from various other sources such as socio-economic and political factors, as well the interaction and intersections of the two areas.

Submissions should be in English. The contributions must be original, previously unpublished material, not being considered for publication elsewhere. Submissions for the next issues of the Muslim World Journal of Human Rights are due no later than February 15, 2008.
